#### Q&A: EMPH Grad and La Maida Project Executive Director Kelly Benshoof, MPH, Takes Public Health Approach to Reverse Rising Levels of Mental Health Challenges

Three years after graduating from UCLA's Executive Master of Public Health (EMPH) Program in 2016, [Kelly Benshoof, MPH](#), launched La Maida Project, a Southern California based nonprofit organization that includes notable board members such as Drew Carey and Jennifer Garner, focused on innovative solutions to the mental health crisis. As the Executive Director, she worked with co-founders Alexis Naim, LCSW, and Omid Naim, MD, to create La Maida Project's health-promoting Ecological Trauma-Informed Model which includes a range of workshops and programs where participants gain the tools to understand their capacity to heal and create change in their own lives and communities. We caught up with Kelly to learn more about her journey in public health and her important work directing the vision at La Maida Project.
